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## Summer Tutors (In-Person): OCT, EA, ECE, CYC Multiple Positions Available

**Summary of Role:** The Learning Disabilities Association of Halton Hamilton offers a variety of in-person summer programs for students with diagnosed or suspected learning disabilities (LDs) and/or ADHD (attention deficit hyperactivity disorder). These include:

- Reading Rocks- a games-based, interactive, literacy program focused on phonics, sight words, fluency and motivation for students struggling with reading
- Mastering Mathematics- a multisensory math program designed to fill numeracy gaps, including number sense, basic operations etc.
- Executive Functioning and Self-Advocacy Programs and others

Training is provided for all programming.

### Responsibilities:

- Undertake training as required
- Provide high quality small group instruction based on the student's needs and pre-program assessment data, where available
- Foster a safe, welcoming, and respectful environment that encourages community building, inclusion, and friendship
- Act as a positive role model
- Complete administrative duties for the program as required, including but not limited to preparing materials for program delivery and developing, distributing, and analyzing evaluation forms in collaboration with our Research Assistant and Program Manager.
- Ensure the health and safety of all students in your care.

**Reports to:** Program Manager and/or Executive Director

**Length of Employment:** Assignments can be flexible with employment for a limited number of weeks or the whole period from July 1<sup>st</sup> to September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022. Full-time and part-time opportunities are available.

**Compensation:** \$25/hour, however Ontario Certified Teachers will be paid a rate of \$30/hour.

**Qualifications:**

- Ontario Certified Teacher, Educational Assistant, Early Childhood Educator, Child and Youth Counsellor, or associated field
- Previous experience working with children and youth with learning disabilities and/or ADHD is preferred
- Previous group facilitation experience is an asset
- Current Vulnerable Sector Screening and Police Check is required
- Current CPR and First Aid training is required
- Current driving license

**Expectations:**

- Conducting oneself in a professional manner as a representative of LDAHH
- Always acting in the best interest of the child
- Ensuring punctuality to the in-person “site” (location could be anywhere in Hamilton or Halton)
- Prompt communication via email and/or phone for program related matters.
